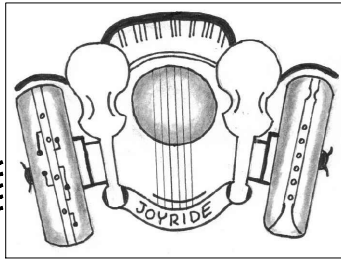


First Wednesday Contra Dance
